*The Advantage Rule: The Referee has the responsibility to NOT call an obvious foul if, by stopping play at that moment, the effect would be to cause greater harm to the team that was fouled with the advantage.

- *There are no throw ins. If the ball goes out of bounds on the sideline, the ball will be place on the spot where it went out and it will be a kick in. Cannot score from a kick in.
- *Players cannot touch the ball inside the arcs. If an offensive player touches the ball in the arc, it will result in a goal kick. If a defensive player touches the ball in the arc, it will result in a goal.
- *A goal can only be scored past midfield (attacking half). If you score a goal that is farther than half field, it will be a goal kick and will not count.

*If a player committs a foul (hand ball or slide/physical foul) when there is an obvious goal scoring opportunity. That player and coach will receive a warning. If it happens again (throughout the whole season), it will result in a red card (thrown out of the game) and that team must play a person down on the field for the duration of that game.
