LAW 17: Misc. 7TH - 12TH GRADE Rules					
*There are no throw ins. If the ball goes out of bounds on the sideline, the ball will be place on the spot where it went out and it will be a kick in. Cannot score from a kick in. *Players cannot touch the ball inside the arcs. If an offensive player touches the ball in the arc or the ball stops in the arc, it will result in a goal kick. If a defensive player touches the ball in the arc, it will result in a goal. *A goal can only be scored past midfield (attacking half). If you score a goal that is farther than half field, it will be a goal kick and will not count. (If the ball hits any player past the midfield line and then goes into the goal, it will count as a goal.) *If a player committs a foul (hand ball or slide/physical foul) when there is an obvious goal scoring opportunity, that player and coach will receive a warning. If it happens again during the game, it will result in the player sitting out for the remainder of the game and that team must play a man down. *Tiebreaker in tournament: 4 kicks from midfield. Different player each kick. No goalie. *If both teams are tied after the first 4 kicks, both teams get one additional kick from the breakout line until the tie is broken. Cannot use a repeated player until every player on the roster has kicked.
