LAW 1: THE FIELD

*Goals outdoors will be secured to the ground.

*Lines are part of the playing field.

*** Each field will have 2 break out lines. When there is a goal kick, the defense must be behind the break out line. Once the ball is kicked, the defenders may cross the line.**

*Home team (first team on schedule) supplies the ball for their match only. *should be inflated from 5-8 lbs. *If the ball becomes damaged, a drop ball will restart the match

*In the event of a serious injury game will be stopped and player should be replaced.

*In the event of a minor injury play will be stopped at the next dead ball and player will be assessed.

*Goalies can change with any player of his/her team that is already playing. Referee must be notified or a yellow card may be issued to both players involved.

***Drop kick is allowed by goalie for u6 and up. There is no heading the ball. *(U15 can head the ball)**

*High kicks (any kick above the waist, with any player nearby) will result in a indirect free kick.

LAW 4: PLAYER'S EQUIPMENT

*Players must not wear anything that is dangerous to herself/himself or other players.					
*Casts can be worn if covered and approved by 1) Referee, 2) Players coach. CASTS MUST BE APPROVED PRIOR TO THE GAME.					
*Soccer cleats can be worn. NO METAL OR TOE CLEATS. U6-up cleats or gym shoes *Pre-K gym shoes only in the spring indoor league. Can wear cleats in the fall outdoor league.					
*SHIN GUARDS ARE MANDATORY.					
*Jersey must be worn and tucked in. Warm weather clothes can be worn underneath the jersey. *Goalies need to wear top distinguishing them from other players and referees					

LAW 5: REFEREE

*Ensures correct number of players for the start of the match. Forfeit time is 5 min. after scheduled start time. Games can be started late but the time will be adjusted to end the game at the normal time.

*Makes sure Law 4 is enforced prior to game.

*Enforces all rules. Does not call incidental contact, focuses on intent of breach. Does not control the match by continually blowing the whistle.

*Stops play by blowing whistle and using correct hand gestures.

*Starts quarters, restart after goal, and penalty kicks with a whistle. Other restarts do not require a whistle.

*Acts professionally.

***Provides distance, when requested, for free kicks. 5 yards for U6, U8 & U14, 8 yards for U10&U12**

*Stops game the moment anyone sees lightning. Can also cancel due to harsh weather conditions. If game is into 3rd, 4th qt. no rematch. Optional if canceled earlier. Coach's discuss at that me. *Administers red/yellow cards. Let's make it a goal not to have any of these. This is a recreation league. Treat players and referees with kindness.

*Act as a timekeeper *Documents game, score

*The Advantage Rule: The Referee has the responsibility to NOT call an obvious foul if, by stopping play at that moment, the effect would be to cause greater harm to the team that was fouled with the advantage.

*Ball must roll forward or backward. Distance does not matter.

*If the kicker touches the ball a second time a indirect kick is awarded to the other team.

*PK in case of a tie. Each team has 5 kicks/chances (by different players). All 5 kicks will be done by one team then the other. The ball will be placed 20 feet from the goal. Both teams will line up on the center line. The kicker will come to the penalty box after they have kicked the next one will come up. The referee will signal when it ready to kick the ball Goalie: Must have one foot on the goal line when the ball is kicked.					
LAW 14: THROW IN

*100% rule. If 100% is not in play same team re-throws until ball is in play *Thrower can't touch ball before it has touched another player. Indirect kick is awarded					
LAW 15: GOAL KICK

*Kicking team players can be inside of penalty area. *Opposing team is outside the penalty area (or behind the build out line) until the ball is kicked. *Kick taken by any team member anywhere inside the goal box. *Ball becomes live as soon as the ball is kicked. The ball does NOT have to leave the penalty area before becoming live.					
LAW 16: CORNER KICK					
*Distance will be given if asked for. *can score goal directly for all ages					
LAW 17: Misc. U15 Rules					
*There are no throw ins. If the ball goes out of bounds on the sideline, the ball will be place on the spot where it went out and it will be a kick in. Cannot score from a kick in. *Players cannot touch the ball inside the arcs. If an offensive player touches the ball in the arc, it will result in a goal kick. If a defensive player touches the ball in the arc, it will result in a goal. *A goal can only be scored past midfield (attacking half). If you score a goal that is farther than half field, it will be a goal kick and will not count. *If a player commits a foul (hand ball or slide/physical foul) when there is an obvious goal scoring opportunity. That player and coach will receive a warning. If it happens again (through out the whole season), it will result in a red card (thrown out of the game) and that team must play a person down on the field for the duration of that game.
